Leh Wi Lan Key Numbers

>7,000	Secondary school teachers trained to teach English and Maths
27,000	Teacher lesson plans in English and Maths produced and distributed
>2.7m	Pupil handbooks in secondary English and Maths produced and distributed
12,500	Teachers and mentors trained on reducing violence in schools
>25,000	Reducing Violence in Schools (RVS) Guides produced and distributed
>300,000	Hygiene kits distributed to girls in junior and senior secondary schools
200	School Support Officers observing and mentoring teachers, and collecting data
>15,000	School support visits carried out by SSOs (pre-Covid-19)
>100,000	Classroom observations conducted by SSOs to support use of lesson plans
>1,300	Secondary school Principals trained in academic leadership
21,400	Parents increase awareness on effective handling of pupil handbooks
45,450	Pupils (27,000), parents (18,000) and teachers (450) sensitised on Covid-19
>5,200	Secondary school students screened for eye glasses and treatment
>3,100	Secondary school students received prescription eye glasses
14,000	Solar lamps distributed to aid vulnerable girls and visually impaired students
940	English Language Braille for JSS and SSS distributed to Special Ed Schools
>2,600	Wind-up radios produced with social norms content for Girls-and-Boys-Clubs
33,000	New Teacher Code of Conduct produced and disseminated in support of TSC
5,400	Girls and boys assessed to monitor learning achievement annually
250	JSS and SSS Principals trialled use of Tangerine for real time school-based reporting (now into rollout to all Principals)
1,400	Tablets loaded with Tangerine for school-based data collection and reporting and training provided (1,200 JSS Principals, 200 inspectors)
